

CANOE TRIP CABIN LEADER

Position Summary:

The role of a Canoe Trip Cabin Leader is to build relationships with the campers participating in this program; to demonstrate and encourage Christian character and lifestyle. Canoe Trip Cabin Leaders will have the opportunity to work with campers through all the challenges and victories their campers go through. As a Canoe Trip Cabin Leader you will canoe and camp in the wilderness along with your leader and campers. The Canoe Trip Cabin Leader reports to the Canoe Trip Leader.

Responsibilities:

- Connect and build relationship with campers one on one throughout the week
- Maintain a healthy atmosphere within the cabin
- Be with campers at all times
- Monitor peer interactions among campers
- Mediate issues amongst campers
- Connect regularly with the Canoe Trip Leader
 - Present any frustrations / miscommunications
 - Present prayer requests for campers or self
 - Approach when needing input of them for camper / staff issues
 - Inform of issues / incidents
- Lead and encourage discussion during devotional and inspirational times
- Honouring and respecting fellow staff and leaders
- Encourage and inspire participation in all programming
- Report to the Activity Leader for evening schedule and other breaks other than scheduled (when onsite)
- Participate to the assigned evening chapel (when onsite)
- Help with the set up and take down of different programming as assigned (when onsite)
- Will stay in a cabin with campers as a cabin buddy and help the cabin leader when necessary (when onsite)
- Participate in the evening programmed activities (when onsite)
- Participate in the evening staff meeting (when onsite)

General Responsibilities:

- Share your Christian life and character with the campers as you can
- Promote an encouraging and fun environment
- Encourage, honour and respect fellow staff and leaders
- Encourage fellow staff
- Honouring and respecting fellow staff and leaders
- Maintain the care of the facility and equipment provided
- Be on time for all scheduled programming and meals
- Be able to participate with enthusiasm in various weather conditions
- Properly care for your designated accommodations
- Uphold all Camp Arnes policies
- Properly care for the accommodations designated
- Promote care for the facility given to campers for their use
- Participate in the Saturday Staff Meeting once the campers have left
- Attend and participate in the Tuesday and Thursday morning Staff devotions
- Attend and participate in Sunday night Journey Groups
- Attend and participate in Sunday night wigwams / worship
- Try to attend church on Sundays (when possible)
