

## **CABIN LEADER**

### **Position Summary:**

The role of a Cabin Leader is to build relationships with the campers in their care; to demonstrate and encourage Christian character and lifestyle. Cabin Leaders will have the opportunity to work with campers through all the challenges and victories their campers go through. As a Cabin Leader you will participate in a variety of programs along with your campers. The Cabin Leader reports to the Day Camp Coordinator and Explorer Camp Leader.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Connect and build relationship with campers one on one throughout the week
- Maintain a healthy atmosphere within the cabin
- Initiate conversations about your relationship with Christ. Share personal Christian life and character with the campers
- May teach an activity in a week
- Be with campers at all times except during scheduled time off
- Monitor peer interactions among campers
- Mediate issues amongst campers
- Report issues beyond your ability to the Camp Leader
- Connect regularly with the Camp Leader in the unit meeting
  - Present any frustrations / miscommunications
  - Present prayer requests for campers or self
  - Approach when needing input of them for camper / staff issues
  - Inform of all issues / incidents
- Promote integration of campers with special needs with other campers
- Lead and encourage discussion during cabin time
- Participate in all programming with campers
- Encourage and inspire participation in all programming
- Report to the Activity Leader for evening schedule and other breaks other than scheduled
- Participate to the assigned evening chapel
- Help with the set up and take down of different programming as assigned
- Will stay in a cabin with campers as a cabin buddy and help the cabin leader when necessary
- Participate in the evening programmed activities
- Participate in the evening staff meeting

### **General Responsibilities:**

- Promote an encouraging and fun environment
- Encourage, honour and respect fellow staff and leaders
- Be on time for all scheduled programming and meals
- Be able to participate with enthusiasm in various weather conditions
- Properly care for your designated accommodations
- Uphold all Camp Arnes policies
- Participate in the Saturday Staff Meeting once the campers have left
- Attend and participate in the Tuesday and Thursday morning Staff devotions
- Attend and participate in Sunday night Journey Groups
- Attend and participate in Sunday night wigwams / worship
- Try to attend church on Sundays (when possible)
