Position Summary:

While lifeguarding has a high demand for performance, we also place a high value on making friends and having fun. Lifeguards are part of the waterfront team. . They are **required** to be NLS certified. This position reports to the waterfront coordinator.

Responsibilities:

- Clean the pool and hot tub as scheduled
- Check chemical of the pool and report to Waterfront Coordinator
- Lifeguard the pool / waterfront as scheduled
- Lifeguard any sneak outs at night as scheduled
- Maintain focus on the instruction and care of the camper during the activity block
- Maintain care for all waterfront equipment i.e. lifejackets, boats, paddles
- High standard of safety for campers
- Inspire excellence from your campers
- Promote and encourage a fun environment
- Report to the waterfront coordinator regularly
- Keep record of the equipment needs and replenishing
- Report **all** incidents/issues to the waterfront coordinator
- Encourage and inspire participation in all programming
- Report to the Activity Leader for evening schedule and other breaks other than scheduled time off
- Participate in scheduled evening events
- May teach waterfront activities as needed
- Participate in the assigned evening chapel
- Help with the set up and take down of different programming as assigned
- Will stay in a cabin with campers as a cabin buddy and help the cabin leader when necessary
- Participate in the evening staff meeting

General Responsibilities:

- Share your Christian life and character with the campers as you can
- Promote an encouraging and fun environment
- Encourage, honour and respect fellow staff and leaders
- Be on time for all scheduled programming and meals
- Be able to participate with enthusiasm in various weather conditions
- Maintain and promote care for the facility and equipment provided
- Properly care for your designated accommodations
- Uphold all Camp Arnes policies
- Participate in the Saturday Staff Meeting once the campers have left
- Attend and participate in the Tuesday and Thursday morning Staff devotions
- Ensure and reward Lifeguards who are at the Tuesday/Thursday morning staff devotions
- Attend and participate in Sunday night Journey Groups
- Attend and participate in Sunday night wigwams / worship
- Try to attend church on Sundays (when possible)
- Uphold all Camp Arnes policies
- Properly care for the accommodations designated
