ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES (Other duties may be assigned)

- Pays attention to detail for long periods of time.
- Communicates safety guidelines in all swimming and waterfront activities and areas.
- Maintains order in swimming areas.
- Inspects swimming areas for cleanliness & conditions.
- Regularly cleans pool according to schedule.
- Rescues swimmers in danger of drowning and administers first aid or CPR in such cases.
- Ensure safety of all activities & programming.
- Promote & demonstrate a well balanced Christian life.

QUALIFICATIONS

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential function satisfactorily. The requirements listed above are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required.

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE

A student in University preferred, at least 2 years in camping environment, a minimum of 1 year of responsible experience in lifeguarding. NLS certification is required. Superior organizational skills and excellent communication are essential to the success of this position.

LANGUAGE SKILLS

Ability to read and comprehend simple instructions, short correspondence, and memos. Ability to write simple correspondence. Ability to effectively present information in one-on-one and small group situations to other employees of the organization.

MATHEMATICAL SKILLS

Ability to add, subtract, multiply, and divide in all units of measure, using whole numbers, common fractions, and decimals.

REASONING ABILITY

Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out detailed but uninvolved written or oral instructions.
