Code of Conduct

We encourage all Camp Arnes Board of Directors, staff and volunteers to demonstrate Christian commitment and a lifestyle which models and reflects the life and teachings of Jesus. The Bible is our guide for a Christian believer's conduct and attitude in relation to themselves and others. Because we are called to love our neighbor as ourselves (Mark 12:29-31), our relationship to Christ will be most evident in our relationship to others. The following behavioral attributes and expectations are described below:

Guiding Principles: I Corinthians 13

Attitude - each Board member, staff and volunteer's personal disposition and attitude is characterized by godliness and the fruit of the Spirit which is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness gentleness and self control. Attitudes of jealousy, envy, judgment, bitterness and unrestrained anger and unwillingness to forgive are condemned in the Scriptures and are to be avoided. Discretion - each Board member, staff and volunteer is expected to practice discretion in the following: smoking, vaping, alcohol, gambling, media and entertainment, recreational drugs and the choices of organizations with which they associate. We are accountable to a supporting public who may have different views on Christian behavior. A guiding principle is to avoid situations which may have a negative impact on self, others and Camp Arnes. Camp staff and volunteers will refrain from smoking, consuming alcoholic beverages and the use of illicit or recreational drugs while at Camp.
