IMPORTANT MEDICATION INFORMATION

Children are more active at Camp than they normally would be at home. Please ensure that any activity related medications are updated and packed.

Medication must be in the ORIGINAL PRESCRIPTION BOTTLE/PACKAGING. Bubble Packs are encouraged and are FREE OF CHARGE, ask your pharmacist.

Please pack sufficient clothes for camper's entire stay at Camp. Laundry facilities are not available for campers.

Camp Arnes Summer Dress Code

- All shirts must cover the midriff (when arms are raised to the shoulder).
- Shorts must be to the fingertips when standing.
- Modest one piece or two piece bathing suits may be worn in swim areas only (i.e. waterfront & pool). Bikinis are not permitted. Shorts and shirts must be worn while walking across the grounds.
- No clothing with inappropriate or offensive words or pictures will be permitted.

Camper Code of Conduct

In order to support the Mission Statement of Camp Arnes, Campers shall refrain from the following while on site:
Adherence to or participation in religious practices contrary to or not in accordance with the Statement of Faith of Camp Arnes;
Adherence to or participation in sectarian and cult organizations and practices;
Engaging in or the on-site promotion of sexual activity outside of traditional marriage or other sexual behavior, such as the use of pornography, that is contrary to or not in accordance with the Statement of Faith or Code of Conduct of Camp Arnes;
Using Camp Arnes facilities to engage in, plan or promote/support activities that are contrary to or not in accordance with the Code of Conduct or religious beliefs reflected in the statement of Faith of Camp Arnes;
Reading or viewing of pornographic material;
Use of non-medical drugs (substance abuse);
Consumption of alcoholic beverages;
Support of or participation in abortion or abortion related activities;
Engaging in racist conduct or supporting racist viewpoints;
Use of profane or blasphemous language;
Engaging in any behavior contrary to the Criminal Code of Canada.

The Camp Director reserves the right to dismiss a camper who in their opinion is a hazard to the safety and rights of others, or who appears to have rejected the reasonable controls of the camp. If this occurs, the fee is non-refundable and parents/guardians are responsible to ensure that any child dismissed from the Camp is picked up in a timely manner.
