

Challengers get to select a skill to engage with daily throughout the week, being encouraged to learn from our various Skills Coordinators as they teach campers how to stay safe, have fun, and grow in their respective skills.

The fun doesn't stop there! Most evenings include a Camp-wide game, a live band and an

engaging speaker. Throw in a few Camp classics like bonfires and roasting marshmellows and it's the perfect way to spend a week of your summer. Ages 11-13 Available All Weeks

Whether you know it or not, **Stokers** is the week of fun and freedom that you've been waiting for! It's where exciting adventure meets authentic relationships. Your week will be filled with skills, along with some Camp classics like bonfires and swimming.

Stokers get to take part in our evening wide games and Lighthouse; complete with a band and a captivating speaker. On top of that Stokers have their own lounge to hang out in and their own special events like Stoker Coffee House!

Beyond all the fun, Stokers are focused on building deep, meaningful

relationships with great people. Camp is a chance for Stokers to slow down and live in the moment, away from all the pressures of their world. In this space, you'll get to engage in face-to-face conversations with friends and cabin leads, giving you the chance to be heard and to hear God loves you! STOKERS 6

If you are looking to do something this summer that makes a lasting impact, then **CREW** is the right place for you! It's a two-week work program that will provide you with practical training and experience for working both in and out of Camp! **CREW** is broken down into three parts:

WORK: Campers spend a chunk of each day doing work projects, helping in our kitchen and dining hall, and assisting in other areas of Camp. Along with the experience, they are taught skills like resume building and how to interview well to help them as they pursue work outside of Camp. **CREW** campers learn how to work hard until the job is done, using their gifts and talents to help others in a positive way!

PLAY: Throughout the work day, **CREW** campers get to play team-building games and have Tuck breaks, but the real fun begins when the work is lone! They get to join in the rest of Camp in

playing wide games, enjoying activities and connecting in Lighthouse. **CREW** also gets their own night activities, including bonfires and Creator's Studio!

You can count your work hours from CREW towards a volunteer credit at school!

7 CREW

RELATIONSHIP: CREW is where you find community unlike any other. Cabin Leads are always there for a laugh and to lend a listening ear. As campers learn to work as a team and get along with a diverse group of people, deep bonds are formed. They are taught to

encourage and build each other up while appreciating one another's differences. Greatest of all, they are taught daily about having a relationship with God, where they are reminded how much He loves them and cares for them!

Ages 15-17 Two Sessions: July 15-27 & August 12-24, 2024 (CREW Participants will return home on weekends)



The Camp Arnes Leadership Training Program (LTP) aims to develop Christlike leaders who meaningfully engage in any community they find themselves in. Through two weeks at Camp, campers will learn from Christian leaders and teachers from across our province, as well as developing personal rhythms of life to help encourage a deeper love and faith in God, whether they're at Camp or back at home!

Leadership campers will have ample time to have fun in Camp activities and games, create life-long friendships and memories and strengthen their relationship with God in a faith-based, Gospel-focused atmosphere. They will also be mentored by trained Cabin Leads and other leadership members who care about seeing young people grow into the young leaders God has made them to be!

HOW TO APPLY If you or your camper are interested in LTP, here's how you can apply today:

Follow the registration process on pg. 14 and make sure to fill out the LTP questionnaire with it, along with providing three references^{*}, in order to complete your application. Every potential LTP camper will be interviewed to determine acceptance into the program!

> *Step Up campers require at least one pastoral or Christian leader reference.

CHOOSE YOUR LEADERSHIP TRACK

STEP UP (16-17)

In Step Up, young believers are trained and challenged to "step up" as cabin leaders. They will receive specialized training and support



to help prepare them for service in Camp ministry including (but not limited to) conflict management, Plan to Protect certification and how to share the Gospel.

Step Up campers have a unique opportunity to put what they've learned to the test by having a chance to volunteer as a junior cabin leader once they've



graduated the program. Their training continues as they get hands-on experience with a Cabin Lead who will help mentor them every step of the way.

STEP IN (15-17)

In Step In, the focus turns out of Camp and into the everyday lives of campers. They will be trained to be a Christ-like leader in their home communities. Whether that's in church, school, their neighbourhoods or even their hometown, Step In equips young people with contemporary leadership skills informed by the Bible so that they can be effective and well-rounded leaders.

Campers will learn leadership skills like understanding various forms of communication, managing and



leading a team and how to manage dissapointment with grace. They'll also be taught on what the Bible says about leadership and how it applies to their own contexts.
