QUALIFICATIONS/CRITERIA

- 1. Desire to grow and learn as demonstrated by a willingness to discover how things work, what makes them work and how to repair them
- 2. Must be willing to work flexible hours to fulfill duties, as well as to be on call in rotation
- 3. Must be in good physical health in order to complete daily tasks
- 4. Must be self-motivated and comfortable working alone
- 5. Ability to interact with guests, campers and staff in a professional manner
- 6. Flexible with work hours as required to fulfill duties
- 7. Openness to mentorship and growth

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO

- 1. Conduct daily chlorine and water readings and keep written records
- 2. Keep the maintenance shed in a clean, organized manner
- 3. Work within the priority sequence to determine the importance of maintenance requests, repairing and addressing the major needs first
- 4. Keep all tractors and other vehicles (as well as any vehicle that has a motor) in good working order, well maintained and fueled
- 5. Keep written records of oil changes, repairs and upcoming maintenance requirements for all equipment.
- 6. Keep tools orderly and in good repair
- 7. Use every tool safely and only for its intended use
- 8. Be responsible that all tools leaving the shop, whether by maintenance staff or others, are signed out and returned upon completion of projects
- 9. Upkeep of grounds; mowing and weed whacking in the summer; snow removal of roadways and parking areas in winter
- 10. Attend regular maintenance meetings as required
- 11. Be alert to maintenance needs around Camp and fill out appropriate forms
- 12. Help lead the spring, summer, fall and winter changeover
- 13. Check the play structure weekly and keep record of repairs needed and made. Address all safety issues immediately
- 14. Be within 20 minutes of availability when on call
- 15. Answer on call issues promptly and deal with them until completion
- 16. Have available and use Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) at all times both for self and other workers.
- 17. Lead and work with volunteers and Summer Program work projects

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Share your Christian life and character with staff and guests as opportunities arise
- 2. Ensure the safety of yourself, other staff, volunteers and guests through safe work practices and in Camp activities
- 3. Assist in secondary duties when needed in other areas of Camp
- 4. Promote an encouraging and fun environment
- 5. Present yourself in a professional manner in appearance and attitude at all times
- 6. Uphold all Camp Arnes policies and procedures
- 7. Do every task with the highest quality and standards in mind
- 8. Contribute to the proper care and maintenance of equipment

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS/ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS

- 1. Requires prolonged sitting or walking
- 2. Requires ability to work in adverse weather conditions, including rain, heat and cold
- 3. Requires stamina to endure physically demanding days or weeks
- 4. Requires ability to lift and move objects weighing up to 25 kilograms
