The pandemic shut down over the past two years has been challenging. We need your financial and prayer support. The message and hope of Jesus at Christmas can dispel fear and bring hope for our board, staff, schools, rental guests and our campers. God's plan for Camp has been ongoing for the past 71 years. We are excited about the future and how God will undertake the work.

We are actively planning our restart for the spring of 2022, with hope of a full Camp session maintaining our unwavering mission to introduce children to the love of Jesus:

- To nurture and develop young people to greater spiritual maturity and Christian character and leadership ability.
- To offer a place of retreat and deeper pursuit of spiritual maturity for church groups.
- To strengthen families with fun and content to nurture their children and their own marriage relationships.

In the past year, we have actively maintained and improved our facilities. We cannot express enough thanks for the many volunteers who have supported Camp over the past months including: work days, fund raising and office support. It's truly humbling and inspiring.

. In the past two years we have undertaken:

- 2020 Families camping and on site local Day Camp.
- 2021 Four weeks of Day Camp at Elmwood MB Church in the summer.
- Ongoing search for senior staff positions.
- Development of new programming opportunities and partnerships.
- Work days The grounds are in beautiful shape due to volunteers mowing and cutting dead trees.
- Roof repairs on Office and staff houses.
- Pool drained and repairs pending the outcome of government grant.

We have undertaken difficult and dramatic reductions in Camp costs and staff over the past two years. With CEWS and CERB funding coming to an end, we anticipate that our current operational needs will be in excess of \$200,000 to cover salaries, maintenance, taxes and utilities until we can open up next spring.

Our anticipated Camp capital startup needs are:

•	Refitting the Kitchen	\$40,000
•	Fix and repair balance of cabins	\$20,000
•	Staff Housing - repair, windows/flooring	\$42,000
•	Program Equipment - rescue boat/pier/bikes	\$75,000
•	Refit other buildings – windows/siding	\$10,000
