- Day four we head back to landing. We debrief and have supper on the way back to Camp.
- There is no prior canoeing ability required, but it will be helpful. Those that already have canoeing ability should help those that don't.
- It's a time for each of us to stand up in leadership and begin to build a strong team!

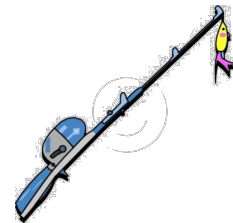
Packing Compact:

Because we need to fit all of our personal belongings, food, equipment and shelter into canoes, it is essential that our personal packs be compact and reasonably lightweight. This is particularly important if the trip involves portaging (most do). It is preferable that you fit all your personal gear into a single bag or pack. One larger pack is much easier to carry and keep track of than 3 or 4 smaller ones. The goal is to use the smallest single bag necessary to carry all of your necessary belongings. (But don't leave behind essential items in your eagerness to pack small. You're going to need that **sleeping bag**!) Use zip lock bags to hold your Bible and journal, camera, toiletries and other essentials. Don't worry; we'll help you pack it up properly before we leave!

Camper Code of Conduct

In order to support the Mission Statement of Camp Arnes, Campers shall refrain from the following while on site:

- Adherence to or participation in religious practices contrary to or not in accordance with the Statement of Faith of Camp Arnes;
- Adherence to or participation in sectarian and cult organizations and practices;
- Engaging in or the on-site promotion of sexual activity outside of traditional marriage or other sexual behavior, such as the use of pornography, that is contrary to or not in accordance with the Statement of Faith or Code of Conduct of Camp Arnes;
- Using Camp Arnes facilities to engage in, plan or promote/support activities that are contrary to or not in accordance with the Code of Conduct or religious beliefs reflected in the statement of Faith of Camp Arnes;
- Reading or viewing of pornographic material;
- Use of non-medical drugs (substance abuse);
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages;
- Support of or participation in abortion or abortion related activities;
- Engaging in racist conduct or supporting racist viewpoints;
- Use of profane or blasphemous language;
- Engaging in any behavior contrary to the Criminal Code of Canada.
