Dear Parents and Guests,

Camp Arnes, along with other camps and organizations, want to do our part to ensure that our guests and user groups are kept as safe as is in our power to do so.

We have been given the go ahead to run family rentals and day camp programming June – August. With that will be many changes from the way we normally run in order to do our best to keep you, our guests and our staff safe.

Our head nurse has prepared a COVID Policy and Procedure manual that we are following. It gives the protocol for checking guests when they arrive, and continuing care through your stay.

Along, with our Nurse, our Food Services Manager and Housekeeper are making sure that we are at Industry Standard for all of our procedures related to food services and sanitation. Our summer day camp staff have also been trained in all of our procedures for hand washing, physical distancing, watching for signs and symptoms and sanitation procedures.

We will be asking that anyone in your party that may have been exposed to COVID-19, or is displaying flu like symptoms refrain from coming to camp, you will be given the opportunity to change your booking to a later date if possible.

We are working to ensure that we have enough sanitation supplies to help to keep our guests safe, we do ask that our guests bring their own hand sanitizer for their accommodation, we will provide it for all public spaces.
